Menon**, Mellon Chair in Indian Studies and the and the Director of the Centre for Indian Studies in Africa, University of the Witwatersrand, Johannesburg) on "About Time: Keralolpathi and Colonial Discourse", **Dr. Satish Deshpande**, Professor, Department of Sociology, Delhi School of Economics, on "Critiquing Commonsense".



About Time : Keralolpathi and Colonial Discourse

The origin legend of Kerala makes an intimate connection between the ocean and the history of region; in fact, the retreat of the ocean makes possible settlement and habitation on the land. The Keralolpathi, or the origin myth of Kerala, is widely believed to have been composed in c. 17th Century CE by Thunjath Ezhuthachan, the "father of Modern Malayalam literature". This attribution could well be to grant legitimacy to a document whose status between myth and history has always been in doubt. It is stated in this chronicle (carita) that Parasurama, the sage of legend, slew 21 generations of Kshatriya warriors and then threw the bloodstained axe into the sea, thus recovering the land of Kerala from the Sea. The text also traces the evolution of kingly rule and social order in this coastal region over the centuries. The focus of the talk is on the First English translation of the Keralolpathi in the late 18th century CE commissioned by Alexander Walker who came to the western coast of India as a young cadet of the East India Company. Influenced by the comparative historical method of the Scottish Enlightenment, Walker read the Keralolpathi sympathetically, putting its notions of temporality within a comparative framework of ancient civilizations. His was one of the earliest attempts to engage with a local sense of time and history in Colonial South Asia.

Critiquing Commonsense

Satish Deshpande is one of the foremost sociologists in India. He took his M.A. (Economics) from JNU and M.A. (Sociology) and Ph.D. (Sociology) from the University of California at Santa Cruz. He has taught at University of Hyderabad, Institute of Economic Growth (Delhi), Centre for the Study of Developing Societies (Delhi), University of Delhi before moving to the Dept. of Sociology, Delhi School of Economics. He works on issues of caste and class inequalities, Politics and the history of social sciences, South-South interactions, Contemporary social theory, Social inclusion and pedagogy, Social space and its interaction with globalization among others. His publications include: *Contemporary India : A Sociological View*, *Untouchability in Rural India* (with Channarayana Shah, Harish Mander, Subodh Thareja and Anand Bhatnagar), *The Problem of Caste* (Editor), *Revealing Inclusion : The Practice of Equal Access in Indian Higher Education* (Co-editor), *Anthropology in the East : Founders of Indian Sociology and Anthropology* (Co-edited). Besides, he has published many research articles and socially relevant popular articles in reputed Indian dailies.

Reviving the Indigenous: Medical Traditions in Twentieth Century Kerala

Dr. Burton Cleetus teaches at the Centre for Historical Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi. He specializes in the History of Medicine in colonial and post-independent India and has worked extensively on Indigenous medical traditions in South India. He did his Masters, M.Phil and Doctoral degrees from Jawaharlal Nehru University and was a Post-Doctoral Fellow at the French Institute of Pondicherry. Burton worked a brief period at the department of History, University of Calicut. Dr. Cleetus is the recipient of the prestigious Rockefeller Foundation research grant (2008), German research grant for Social Sciences, DAAD (2012), and the Indo-Swiss research Grant (2017). He has presented papers at various International and National conferences, including at the Universities of Tübingen, Heidelberg, Ludwig Maximilian University, Germany, at the University of Zurich, Switzerland, at McMaster University, Canada, at Penn-state University, US, CNRS, Paris, Rio National University, Brazil, and Oxford, Glasgow and at Warwick in the UK.
