DRESS, BEHAVIOUR AND DISCIPLINE

- 1. Every students shall wear clean, and respectable dress
- 2. Students should be decorous in language and behaviour
- 3. Students are expected to salute the members of staff the first time they meet them in the course of the day.
- 4. On any member of the staff or any visitor entering the class the students shall rise and remain standing till they are desired by him to sit or till he has taken his seat.
- 5. No student shall leave the class until after the Lecturer has left except with the permission of the Lecturer.
- 6. Students are forbidden from entering any Laboratory except with the permission of the Lecturer-in-charge
- 7. Students are expected to observe due silence and self restrain during the intervals between classes as well as mid-day lunch interval.
- 8. Students should move from one classroom to another in an orderly and disciplined manner. All their movements about the college should conform to standards of academic decorum and dignity.

- 9. Furniture should not be dislocated. All serious of wilful damage will be required to be paid for together with such penalty as may be imposed by the Principal
- 10. Any disfigurement or damage done to college building, water, gas, fire and electrical installations, gardens and premises will be punished and the cost of the damages, if, any, will be recovered.
- 11.Students are forbidden to organise or attend any meeting in the college or to collect money for any purpose without the express permission of the Principal.

The concessions if any granted to pupils will be cancelled if they resort to or participate in strike etc. The educational concessions awarded to the children and dependants of Defence Service Personnel and the scholarships awarded by the Department are liable to forfeiture for "misconduct" and the concession and scholarships may be withdrawn from pupils who resort to or participate in strikes.

12. Students will be expelled from the college for breach of discipline by the Principal in consultation with the college council and there can be no appeal to the decision taken by the college council.
