

The floods and landslides triggered by heavy monsoon had wreaked havoc at Kavalappara in Malappuram(Dt). Accordingly, remedial measures to bring the residents back on track became imperative. In this regard, the yeoman service executed by the NSS unit of K.K.T.M Government College, Pullut, Kodungallur was remarkable and exemplary. I am personally impressed by the diligence and patronage received from NSS unit of the college. Loads of groceries, dresses and stationery items were carried in a truck to the spot accompanied by the students of the Unit to carry out rescue operations. The tribal community of the area were also battered by the flood. The NSS unit was engaged in a fund collection drive and the amount was utilized for the construction of temporary sheds for the homeless tribes. At the outset, toilets and bathrooms were cleaned and drinking water was distributed. Students also brought food parcels, gas cylinder, medicines and blankets from outside. They took initiative to visit KSEB and convince them of averting power cuts from the camp. Cleaning materials, detergents, Dettol etc. were also distributed among the flood victims. The services put forth by the students of NSS unit were inestimable and timely and they proved to be the role models for others to emulate.
