9. Flood Relief Camps are started in the college

In the month of August 2018, when Kerala faces the flood due to heavy rain and the relief camps are started in the college N.S.S. Volunteers actively participated in various relief activities in the camp. After the flood in association with the local bodies of the flood affected areas of the District, volunteers worked well in the cleaning of homes, relief camps, Data collection of damages and in rehabilitation process. Units collected an amount of R.s. 1, 50,000/- and gave it to Two flood victims of Poyya Grama Panchayath for the reconstruction of their homes and Joined in the Programme of the Kerala State 'Rebuild Kerala'. Units donated an amount of 5000/- to a Volunteer who was affected by flood.



10. Flood Relief to the camp – Donation of Essentials

In the month of August 2018, when Kerala faced the natural calamity called 'Pralayam'(FLOOD) essential items were distributed to the camps which acted as flood relief camps under the leadership of KKTm Government College NSS Unit. All food items, medicines, clothes and utensils were collected under the leadership of NSS and distributed to the required flood relief camps.



11. Flood Relief Fund Donation at Poyya Gramapanchayath

Kodungallur Pullut, K,K,T,M Government College provided Rs 75000 each for the reconstruction of the houses of Maithili A K and Lini Rajesh in the flood affected areas of Poyya Gram Panchayat, Wards 13 and 15, from the funds collected by the NSS units. This project was implemented as a part of collaboration with Kerala Government's Nava Keralam project.





12. Cleaning the campus after flood relief camp

KKTM College worked as a flood relief camp when Kodungallur and surrounding areas were hit by floods. After the water receded in the surrounding areas, the college campus was cleaned under the leadership of NSS volunteers, which acted as a flood relief camp.



13. Cleaning the flood relief camps and Houses after flood at Thuruthoor

The flood that affected the whole of Kerala, the houses and other things got flooded in a big way. People shifted to relief camps. After the water receded, cleaning operations were carried out under the leadership of KKTm Government

College NSS to make the houses habitable. The volunteers of the NSS unit also undertook the cleaning of schools and other government institutions that functioned as relief camps.



Units also observed World Environment day, Independence Day, Teachers Day N.S.S. Day, One Week Service for Gandhi Jayanthi, One week celebration for National Integration, Energy conservation Day as per the direction of the State and District N.S.S. Co-ordination council. Volunteers are effectively participated in the competitions and speeches arranged in connection with the observation of these days.
