Webinars

A series of webinars were conducted by the Dept. of Zoology, which were open to students and faculty from colleges, all across Kerala. Five webinars conducted were:

1. Webinar on "Interpretation of biological data with bioinformatics"

The Department organized a webinar on "Interpretation of biological data with bioinformatics Interpretation of biological data with bioinformatics' on 22-09-2021, from 2.00 to 4.00 PM. The programme was inaugurated by Dr. Nesy E. A., Principal, KKTM Govt. College, Pullut. Dr. Seema Menon, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Zoology co-ordinated the programme. Dr. Shaji E M, Head and Assistant Professor of the department gave away the felicitations. Mrs. Prisho Mariam Paul, M.Phil. Bioinformatics, Assistant Professor, Department of Biotechnology, CMS College, Kottayam was the resource person. Her talk focused on the application of tools of computation and analysis to the capture and interpretation of biological data. Bioinformatics is essential for management of data in modern biology and medicine. She also described the main tools of the bioinformatician and discussed how they are being used to interpret biological data and to further understand diseases. The potential clinical applications of these data in drug discovery and development were also discussed. There were 177 delegates attending the webinar from various higher educational institutions of Kerala. Mrs. Soumya K C., Assistant Professor of the department, proposed the vote of thanks.

2. Wetland day Celebration 2021-22

The Department of Zoology at KKTM Govt. College Pullut organized a seminar on World Wetland Day on February 12, 2022, in collaboration with the Bhoomitra Club and the Department of Zoology. The event aimed to raise awareness about the

importance of wetland conservation. The program was initiated with a prayer led by Sandra Bose, a 3rd year B.Sc. Zoology student.

Dr. Shaji E M, the Head of the Department of Zoology, presided over the event, bringing an air of authority and expertise. The function was inaugurated by Dr. Nesy E A, the Principal of KKTM Govt. The seminar saw the participation of a diverse group of 62 students from various schools across Kerala, signifying the interest and concern of the youth for environmental matters.

Internal Examinations

Being an integral part of the evaluation of CUCBCSS, the department conducted centralized online internal examinations, ensuring enough coverage of the content, time, number of questions, and maximum marks as set by the University. An internal examination committee is already in operation; and the department strictly adheres to the directions of the committee. Internal marks are distributed to the learners as per their performance. All students of the department take the benefit of internal examinations.

Charitable activities

Faculty of the department cooperated in helping the COVID-19 students. Besides the faculty members contributed personally to charity activities like SOS - Delhi based Charity firm, helping to adopt and educate abandoned children. Assistance was also given to some local charity funds when the concerned persons approached the department.

Maintenance of aquarium

About 12 aquariums are maintained in the department and students are given training on setting up an aquarium. Through this, the department aims to open a platform for developing a vocation by acquainting them with various aspects of aquarium management. Since the students are maintaining the aquariums, it gives them an opportunity to get acquainted themselves with various techniques related to it for themselves. Every year nearly 30 students are trained in this way.

Tutorial programmes

Tutorial programmes are routinely carried out by the department. For these concerned tutors select the needy students from their classes and discuss selected topics and provide study materials including model questions, condensed notes, mnemonics for essay type questions, etc. The programme is usually charted to half an hour following the class hours. Supervised study and peer teaching are also

carried out to improve the efficacy of this programme. All students of the department received the benefit of this programme.

Class PTA meetings

A regular rapport is maintained with the parents through PTA meetings. Meetings were convened once in every semester, generally after internal examinations. Both academic matters and others related to general discipline and improvement of the students were discussed in detail and suggestions from parents were also sought. Many of the parents expressed their concern about the diminishing result percentage. The meetings were conducted online.

CMV & CV camps

Department of Zoology conducted Centrally Monitored Valuation camps of University of Calicut for B.Sc. Zoology, Aquaculture & Human physiology Core and Complementary papers during this academic year.

Study tour

During 2021-2022, a study tour was conducted for three days to an ecologically significant hill station Ramakkalmedu, ldukki district. The principal granted permission for this study tour as per Order no. A2781/2022/KKTM GC Kodungallur, Dated 22.03.202. All final year B. Se. Students (27 girls and 3 Boys) participated in this programme and the students were accompanied by Dr. Shaji E. M. (Associate Professor, Dept. of Zoology) and Ms. Soumya K.C. (Assistant Professor, Dept. of Zoology).

The team started the journey by I pm on 23.03.2022 and reached Ramakkalmedu by 7 pm. The team stayed at Hill view hotel, Ramakkalmedu for the night. On 24.03.2022 after breakfast, the team visited different ecologically significant hill stations around Ramakkalnmedu. Students got

an opportunity to study the flora and ecosystems associated with hilly regions of the area. The team members took rest in the same hotel on the night of that day. On the next day, the team started the return journey at 8 am and reached the college campus around 2 pm.

Inauguration of Butterfly Garden Project


