Keynotes: The golden shower tree, The leaves are deciduous, The

flowers are produced in pendulous racemes.

Uses: The leaves have also been used to supplement the diets of cattle, sheep, and goats fed with low-quality forages. A paste of the flowers is used as an ointment for pimples.
