The Spoken English Add-On Course spanned 30 days, with the primary objective of refining participants' communication skills and fostering fluency in spoken English. The programme accommodated 46 students, organized into three sections, each comprising 15 students, to ensure effectiveness in instruction. The course commenced on October 14, 2022, and concluded on February 28, 2023. The instructional delivery method employed a blend of both online and offline modalities, strategically chosen to accommodate the diverse preferences and accessibility considerations of the participants.

Objectives:

- 1. Improve participants' spoken English proficiency.
- 2. Enhance participants' confidence in using English in various communication situations.
- 3. Provide a comprehensive understanding of grammar, vocabulary, and pronunciation.
- 4. Foster interactive and engaging learning experiences.

Course Structure:

The course was divided into daily sessions lasting approximately one hour each. The curriculum covered various aspects of spoken English, including grammar, vocabulary building, pronunciation, and practical communication skills. Both online and offline resources were utilized to facilitate an immersive learning environment.

The online sessions were conducted via Google Meet, allowing participants to join from the comfort of their homes for 2hrs. The sessions included live lectures, interactive discussions, and virtual group activities to simulate real-life communication scenarios. Online resources such as multimedia presentations, interactive quizzes, and digital learning materials were also utilised.

Participants were encouraged to actively participate in discussions and share their experiences, creating a collaborative learning environment.

Conclusion:

The Spoken English Add-On Course successfully achieved its objectives, with participants demonstrating improved spoken English skills and increased confidence in communication. The combination of online and offline modes contributed to the course's effectiveness, ensuring accessibility and engagement for all participants


