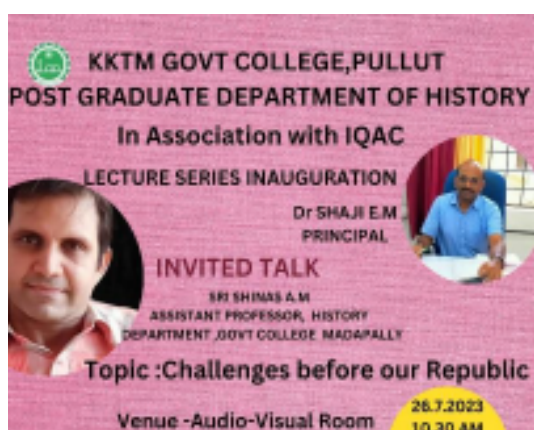

EXTENSION ACTIVITIES-COLLABRATIONWITH KODUNGALLUR EDUCATION DEPARTMENT- 13-2-2024

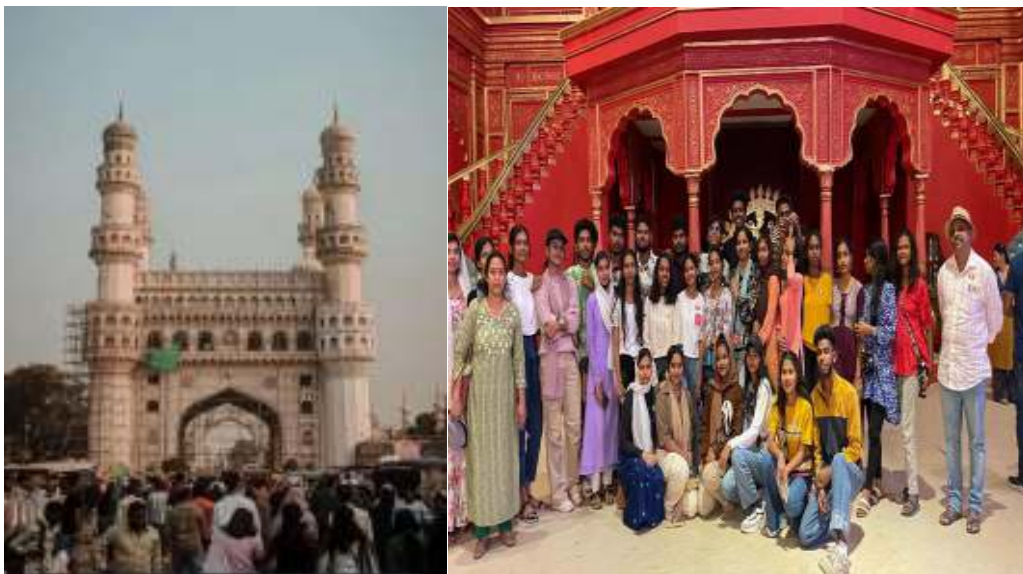
