ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

❖ WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY CELEBRATIONS 2023, ON 05-06-2023

The programme was jointly organized by KKTM SEEDS, Department of Zoology and Bhoomitrasena of KKTM Government College in association with VKRM GHSS ecoclub and KKTMGGHSS NSS unit, Kodungallur. The president of KKTM seeds, Smt. Arya Ramachandran welcomed the audience. The chief guest of the programme Dr. V.S. Vijayan, Chairman, Salim Ali foundation inaugurated the function. The programme was presided over by Dr. Shaji E. M., Principal, KKTM Government College. The seminar brought together renowned scientists, researchers, and experts from around the world to discuss and exchange insights on the latest advancements in the field of biological research. The event aimed to foster collaboration, share cutting-edge techniques, and promote a deeper understanding of key challenges and opportunities in contemporary biological research.

In the inaugural session on Day 1, Smt. Soumya K. C., the Coordinator, extended a warm welcome to the attendees. Dr. Shaji E. M., Head of the Department of Zoology, delivered the Presidential Address, highlighting the significance of advancing biological research. The formal inauguration was carried out by Dr. Bindu Sharmila T. K., Principal, with felicitations from Dr. G Ushakumari, Vice Principal, and Dr. Lovely George, IQAC Coordinator. 
