Annual Report for 2023-24

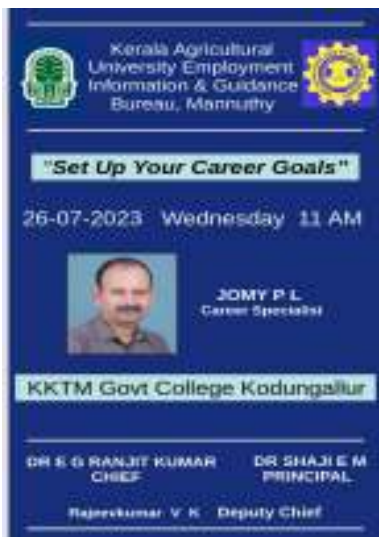
