
WORLD ENVIRONMENTAL DAY CELEBRATIONS 2023 KKTM GOVERNMENT COLLEGE PULLUT



Report on Hands-On Training Programme on Roof Top Farming for College Students

He emphasized the importance of organic farming practices and the role of urban agriculture in mitigating urban heat islands and improving
