
Pass Percentage Report for the Academic Year 2023-24



The results of various courses at KKTM Government College, Pullut, Kodungallur, for the academic year 2023-24 reveal significant variations in pass percentages across programs.

Among the undergraduate programs, BTTM (Bachelor of Tourism and Travel Management) achieved the highest pass percentage of 77.42%, indicating strong student performance and effective course delivery. This is closely followed by B.A. History, with 72.09%, and B.Sc. Zoology, with 70.83%, both reflecting commendable achievements. The B.A. Malayalam program also demonstrated notable success, with 70.21% of students passing.

Anjana T.B., a student of Bachelor of Tourism and Travel Management (BTTM), has achieved the remarkable distinction of securing the **First Rank** in the final semester examinations of Calicut University for the academic year 2023-24. This outstanding accomplishment highlights her dedication, hard work, and academic excellence.

In addition to Anjana's exceptional success, other students from the BTTM program have also demonstrated commendable achievements. **Gangadevi A.P.** secured the 3rd position, **Gopika Karappilly** achieved the 8th position, and **Aswathy P.** earned the 14th position in the same examinations.

These accomplishments reflect the consistent academic excellence and commitment of the students, bringing pride and recognition to the institution. In contrast, some undergraduate courses recorded relatively low pass percentages. For instance, B.Sc. Mathematics had the lowest pass percentage of just 14.29%, pointing to possible challenges in student comprehension or curriculum delivery. Similarly, B.Sc. Applied Physics and B.Sc. Polymer Chemistry displayed moderate performance, with pass rates of 47.62% and 47.37%, respectively.

Jyothi U.B. and **Anjana P.**, students of B.Sc. Applied Physics, have achieved the remarkable distinction of securing the **First Position** in the Calicut University B.Sc. Applied Physics results. Their exceptional performance is a testament to their dedication, perseverance, and academic excellence. Similarly, **Midhunkrishna** has also brought pride to the institution by securing the Third Position in the same examinations. These outstanding achievements highlight the hard work and commitment of the students, adding to the academic prestige of the institution.

For postgraduate programs, the results are mixed. The M.A. Malayalam course stood out with an exceptional pass percentage of 91.67%, showcasing outstanding academic excellence and faculty efforts. Conversely, the M.Sc. Mathematics program recorded a low pass percentage of 33.33%, highlighting a need for closer attention to academic support and teaching methodologies. The M.A. History program showed moderate success with 47.83%.

Overall, the results reflect areas of strength, particularly in language studies and tourism, while also indicating the need for improvement in science and mathematics disciplines. Targeted interventions, such as enhanced student support systems, revision of curriculum strategies, and improved teaching methodologies, could address these disparities and foster better outcomes across all courses in the coming academic years.
