Annual Report for 2024-25

Introduction: The Career Guidance and Placement Cell of the college continues to play a pivotal role in empowering students to make informed decisions about their future endeavours. Throughout the year, our focus remained on providing comprehensive support and resources to assist students in navigating their career pathways beyond undergraduate studies.

A series of seminars and interactive sessions were conducted to enlighten students about the multitude of career options available after completing their undergraduate degrees. Experts in career guidance counselling shared insights, trends, and opportunities, helping students gain a deeper understanding of potential career paths. These seminars aimed to equip students with the knowledge and confidence needed to make well-informed career decisions.

Programme 1- A Career guidance awareness seminar on 'Employment Registration and Employability' on 01.11.2024 at 10.30am.

Venue: College Audio Visual Room

In collaboration with Women and Child Development department, Thrissur, the Career Guidance Cell facilitated on the occasion of International Rural Woman's Day a seminar and one-on-one counselling sessions to help students set realistic and achievable future goals. The resource person for the seminar was Sri Shaju Lonappan M, Employment Officer, Vocational Guidance, District Employment Exchange, Thrissur. Through interactive activities and personalized guidance, the speaker, who is an experienced academic counsellor, encouraged the students to reflect on their strengths, interests, and aspirations, enabling them to chart a clear path towards their desired career outcomes. 84 students of final year UG attended the seminar. The seminar proved to be an enlightening and enriching experience for all participants.







Programme 2- A seminar on DWMS Registration & Employability Enhancement Training on 28.01.2025 at 2.30pm.

Venue: College Auditorium

The objective of the seminar is to introduce final-year UG students to the **Digital Workforce Management System (DWMS)**, a Kerala Government initiative by the Kerala Knowledge Economy Mission (KKEM), and to enhance their employability through targeted training programs. This session aims to bridge the gap between academic learning and industry requirements, ensuring that final-year UG students are well-prepared to embark on their professional journeys. The resource person who engaged the session was Smt. Anitha V R, a KKEM Curator.

DWMS is an AI-driven platform connecting job seekers with employers, offering features like job matching, resume building, and career counselling. The students were given step-by-step guidance on creating a profile, completing the Career Inclination Survey, and utilizing the Robotic Interview feature. The session emphasised on the importance of active participation in the Employability Enhancement Training Modules available on the platform, encouraging students to keep their profiles updated to increase visibility to potential employers. From this session students will gain a comprehensive understanding of the DWMS platform and its benefits. Through targeted training modules, students will develop skills crucial for securing employment. Psychometric assessments and career counselling will help students align their strengths with suitable career paths. 91 students across various disciplines attended the seminar.





Programme 3 - Career development seminar- PSC orientation on 19.02.2025 at 3.00 pm

Venue: Seminar Hall

Objective of the session was to introduce final-year undergraduate students to the Kerala Public Service Commission (Kerala PSC), its recruitment processes, and to provide guidance on preparing for various state government examinations. The resource person Sri Ramesh Kumar discussed in detail on various examination categories such as Degree Level, 10th Level, and 12th Level exams. He gave guidance on sourcing and utilizing study materials effectively, stressed on the importance of regular practice through mock tests and previous years' question papers. 32 students participated in the session.


