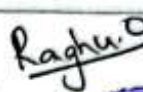

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

This non-binding memorandum of understanding (MoU) was made and entered into on the 1st January 2026 between the M/s. **Ayurgreen Scientifica Research Institute LLP**, Ayurgreen Campus, Kavilpadi, Kaladi, Malappuram - 679 582, Kerala, India, (hereinafter called "ASRI" which expression shall include its successors and permitted assignees) and **Department of Physics, KKTm Govt. College, Pullut P O, Thrissur- 680663, Kerala, India**, (hereinafter called "KKTm" which expression shall include its successors and permitted assignees). **Partner Institute** and **KKTm** are hereinafter individually referred to as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties" as the context may require.

This MoU is non-binding in nature and does not create any legal obligations between the Parties, except for the intellectual property provisions. The partner institute and KKTm agree to collaborate and co-operate with each other work to enhance the quality of research activities.

The agreement has entered into this MoU because they recognize the mutual interest in the fields of research, training, and dissemination of knowledge and also recognize the importance of the industry partner within its field of expertise.

I-The Objectives of this MoU are:

1. To formalize the collaboration between ASRI and KKTm in the joint development, submission, and execution of research proposals and to define the terms of cooperation, including the submission of the proposal to funding agencies and the division of project funds according to each party's contribution.
2. To provide opportunities for researchers to use expertise and facilities available in both institutions under a mutually agreed framework through training, conducting experiments, and exchange of thoughts through sessions/seminars/workshops and

conferences.

3. To jointly publish research papers in reputed international journals and own intellectual property rights resulting from the research, with specific terms to be agreed upon in a separate intellectual property agreement.
4. To encourage any other activities that both institutions agree to be mutually beneficial by co-organizing seminars, workshops, and conferences to present research findings, discuss new ideas, and explore emerging trends in their respective fields.

ASRI and KKTm agree that cooperation in research academic collaborations would be mutually beneficial. The areas of cooperation may include, subject to mutual consent, any desirable and feasible activity that would further the goals of each institution.

II. Proposed Modes of Collaboration

- a. Submitting joint research proposals to national and international funding agencies in the area of scientific and pre-clinical research of mutual interest. For this purpose, the roles and responsibilities of participating members will be finalized on the mutual discussion between the parties hereto in advance and confirmed by an exchange of communication. The joint proposals will be submitted to relevant funding agencies, ensuring compliance with submission guidelines and deadlines.
- b. The project funds received from funding agencies will be divided according to each party's contribution, considering factors such as personnel effort, resources and facilities provided, and intellectual input. A detailed budget will be created, outlining all anticipated costs, and both parties will agree on the allocation of funds. Both institutions will appoint financial officers to oversee the management and distribution of funds, ensuring compliance with the agreed budget and financial guidelines to ensure transparency and accountability in the use of project funds.
- c. Both institutions will share their research infrastructure, including laboratories, equipment, and other facilities, under a mutually agreed framework to support collaborative research projects. The procedural aspects of collaboration include analytical characterization from both **ASRI** and **KKTm**, and clinical research studies from **Ayurgreen Ayurveda Hospitals** under the monitoring of **ASRI**.
- d. Both institutions will co-organize seminars, workshops, conferences, and certificate programs to present research findings, discuss new ideas, and explore emerging trends in their respective fields.
- e. Reciprocal placement of students in paid internships, projects, and co-ops, when possible.
- f. Any other appropriate mode of interaction agreed upon between both institutions including encouraging the regular/ visiting faculty members and scientists of either institute to visit the other institute for giving talks in lectures/programs.

III. Agreements for Research Collaboration

Each research collaboration undertaken by the parties here under shall be initiated by the signing of a separate research agreement between the parties, which will describe in detail:

- a. The nature, scope, and schedule of the research collaboration.
- b. The form of the research collaboration.
- c. The estimated cost of the research collaboration together with the amount of funding, if any, to be received from third parties.
- d. The treatment of intellectual property and data rights, including patents, industrial design registration, copyrights, and all other proprietary information (including innovations not patented, designs not registered, etc.) that result from the research collaboration or which belong to a party and are used in research collaboration.
- e. Other provisions as may be mutually agreed upon, including provisions covering the consequences of default or termination by a participant, term, arbitration of disputes, and applicable law.

IV. Non-Exclusivity

The relationship of the parties under this MoU shall be nonexclusive and both Parties, including their affiliates, subsidiaries, and divisions, are free to pursue other agreements or collaborations of any kind. However, when entering into a particular research agreement, the participants may agree to limit each party's right to collaborate with others on that subject.

V. Intellectual Property

ASRI and KKTM agree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property. Further, the intellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or activity under this MoU will be worked out on a case-by-case basis and will be consistent with the officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutions.

VI. Terms and Termination

This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for ten years and may be continued thereafter with suitable review and agreement. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution six months in advance. However, ASRI and KKTM will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to be completed successfully.

VII. Relationship

Nothing in this MoU shall be construed to make either party a partner, an agent, or a legal representative of the other for any purpose.

VIII. Assignment

It is understood by the Parties herein this MoU is based on the professional competence and expertise of each party and hence neither Party shall transfer or assign this Agreement, or rights or obligations arising hereunder, either wholly or in part, to any third party.

IX. Costs of the MoU

Each Party shall be are the respective costs of carrying out the obligations under this MoU.

X. Signed in Duplicate

This MoU is executed in duplicate with each copy being an official version of the Agreement and having equal legal validity.

BY SIGNING BELOW, the Parties, acting by their duly authorized officers, have caused this Memorandum of Understanding to be executed, effective as of the day and year first above written.
