Report

The Alumni Committee of KKTM Government College, Kodungallur worked to strengthen the bond between the college and its alumni during the academic year 2025–2026. After the renewal of the registration of the KKTM Government College Alumni Association, a new Executive Committee took charge. The Association actively took part in discussions with the college regarding academic activities, infrastructure development, student welfare, and future plans for the institution. The Alumni Association organized **Samagamam 2026**, the annual alumni meet, on 4 January 2026. Alumni from different batches and alumni chapters attended the programme. The event helped strengthen the connection between the alumni and the college.

The Alumni Association donated ₹60,000 for conducting the Second Convocation Ceremony of the college. It also started a Student Financial Assistance Scheme for the 2025–2026 academic year. Under this scheme, three financially needy students from each department receive ₹500 per month. The assistance is given for ten months, excluding the vacation months of April and May. The scheme started in December 2025, and the first instalment for the first four months has already been distributed to the students.

KKTM SEEDS, a charitable society, continued its valuable academic and social service activities. The society continued the endowment programme for the University Rank Holders and students securing First position in the UG and PG examinations. It also provided financial assistance for conducting the Kunjikuttan Thampuran Memorial Programme (Kunjikuttan Thampuran Anusmaranam), organized in memory of Mahakavi Kunjikuttan Thampuran, after whom the college is named. In addition, KKTM SEEDS extended financial assistance for the cancer treatment of an undergraduate student of the Department of Malayalam, reflecting its commitment to student welfare

The KKTM Alumni UAE Chapter also continued its support to the college. As part of the World Environment Day celebrations, they organized a tree planting programme on the college campus. It donated about 500 books to the College Library. The chapter's earlier donations, including water purifiers for the college campus and an incinerator for the Women's Hostel, continue to benefit students and staff.

The Alumni Committee thanks the Alumni Association, KKTM SEEDS, the UAE Chapter, and all alumni for their valuable support. Their contributions to student welfare, academic excellence, infrastructure development, and environmental activities have helped the college in many ways. The committee looks forward to more support and active participation from the alumni in the coming years.
