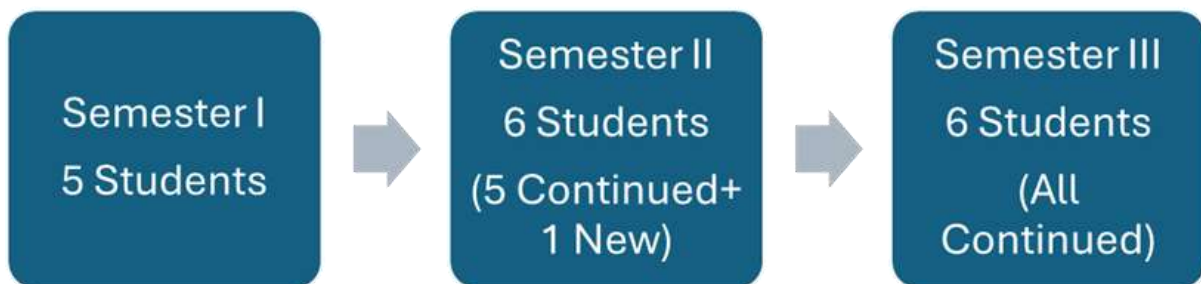

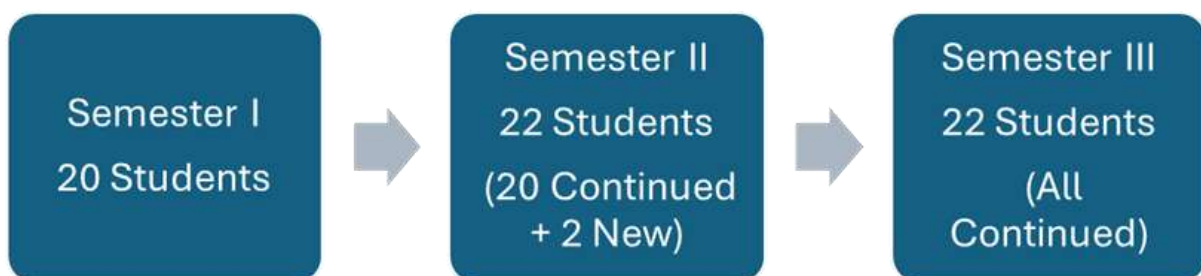

Minor Programme 1 – English for Content Creation

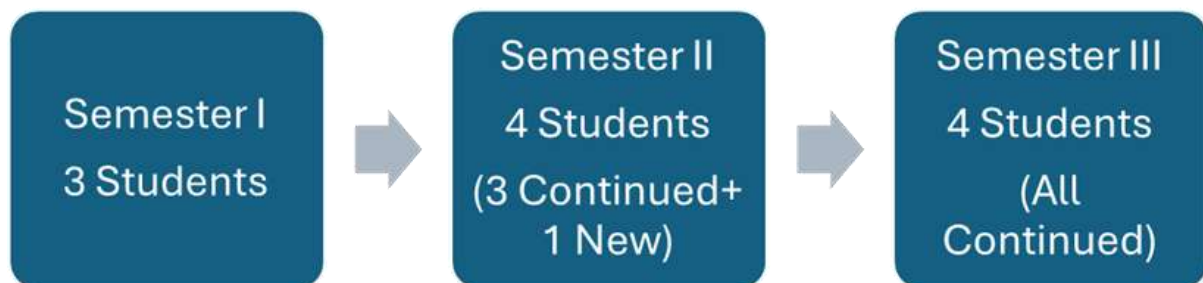
2024 Admission



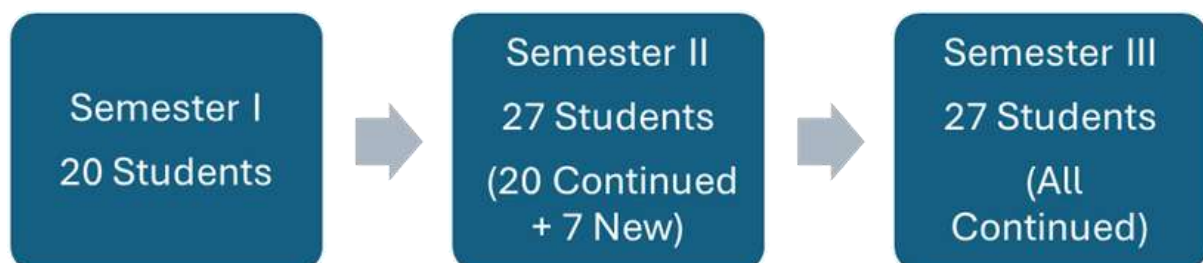
2025 Admission

- **ENG1MN102 The Language of Digital Space: English and New Media**

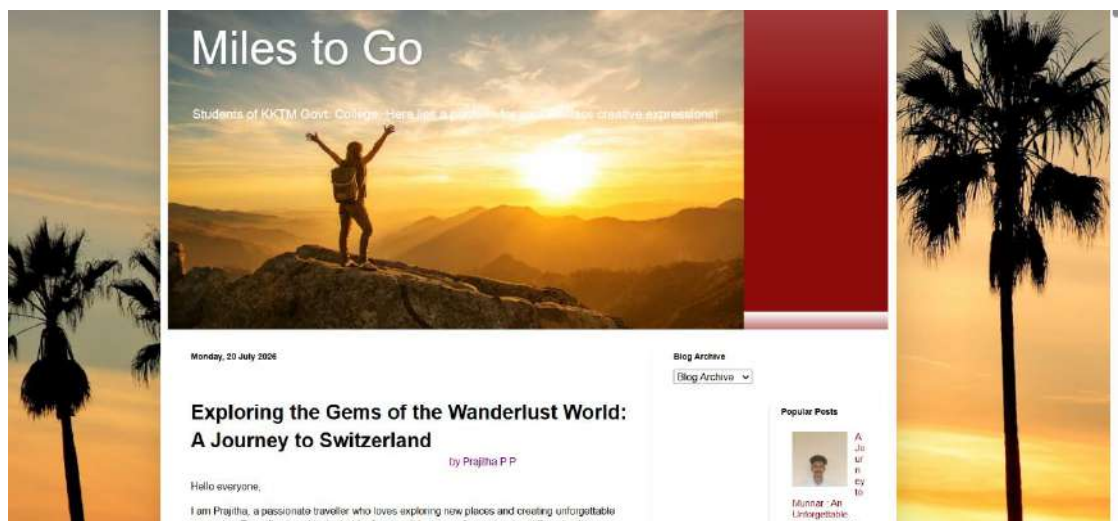

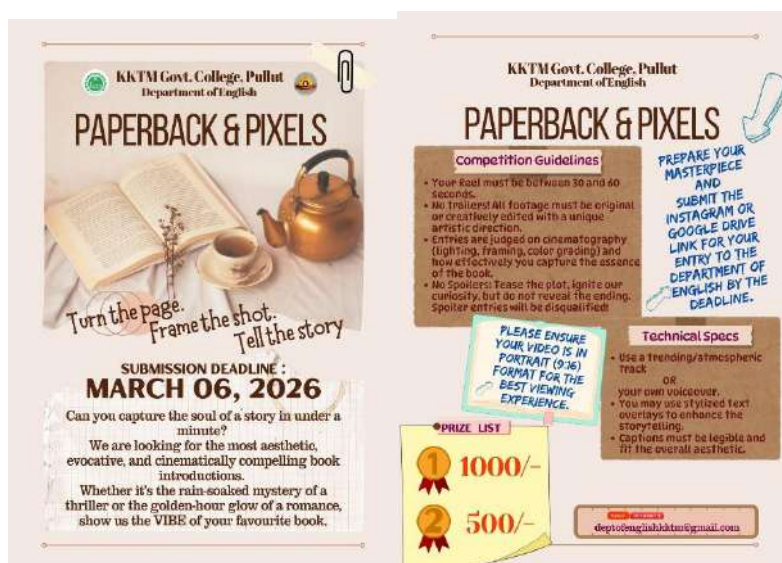
2. Student Blog – *milestogokktmstudents.blogspot.com*
